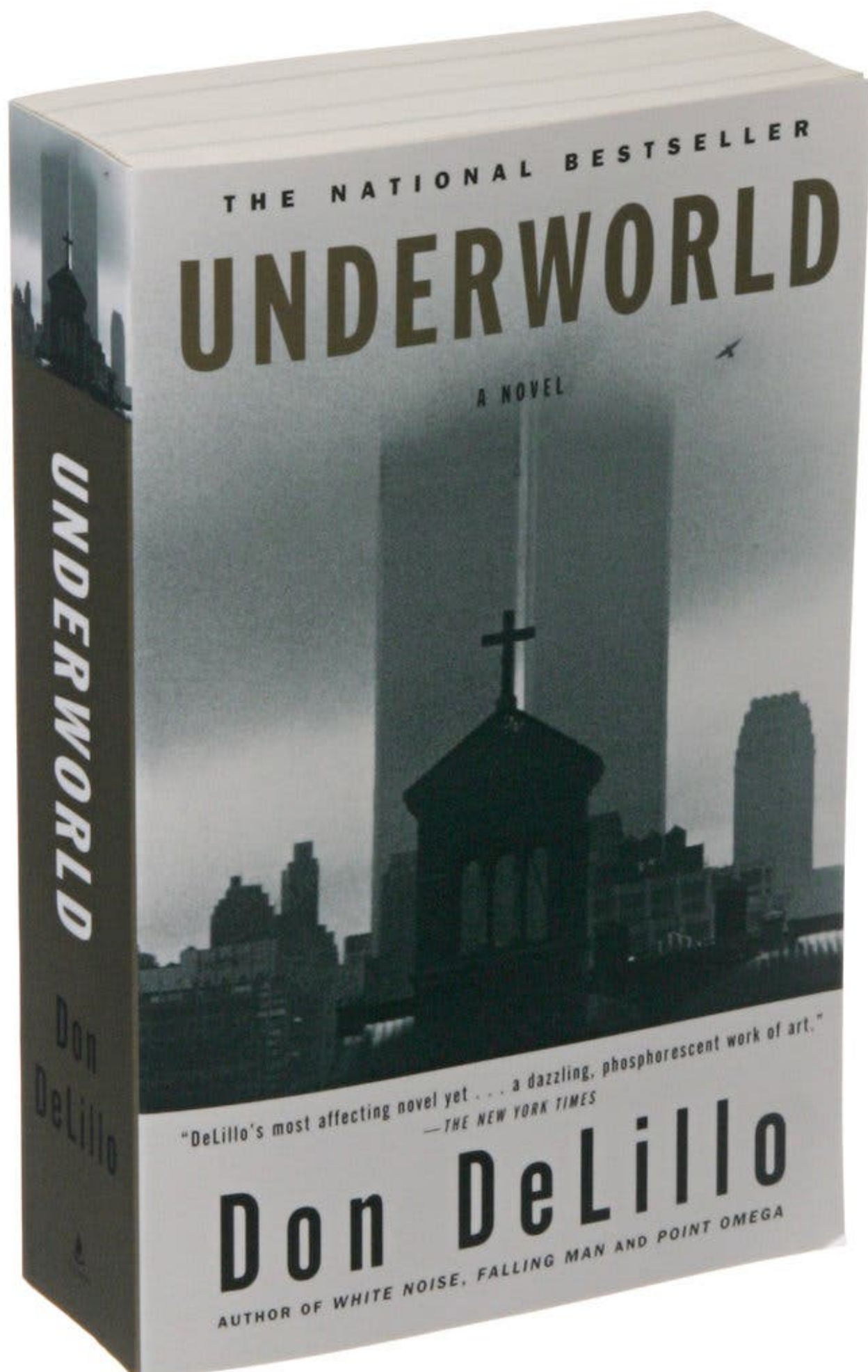

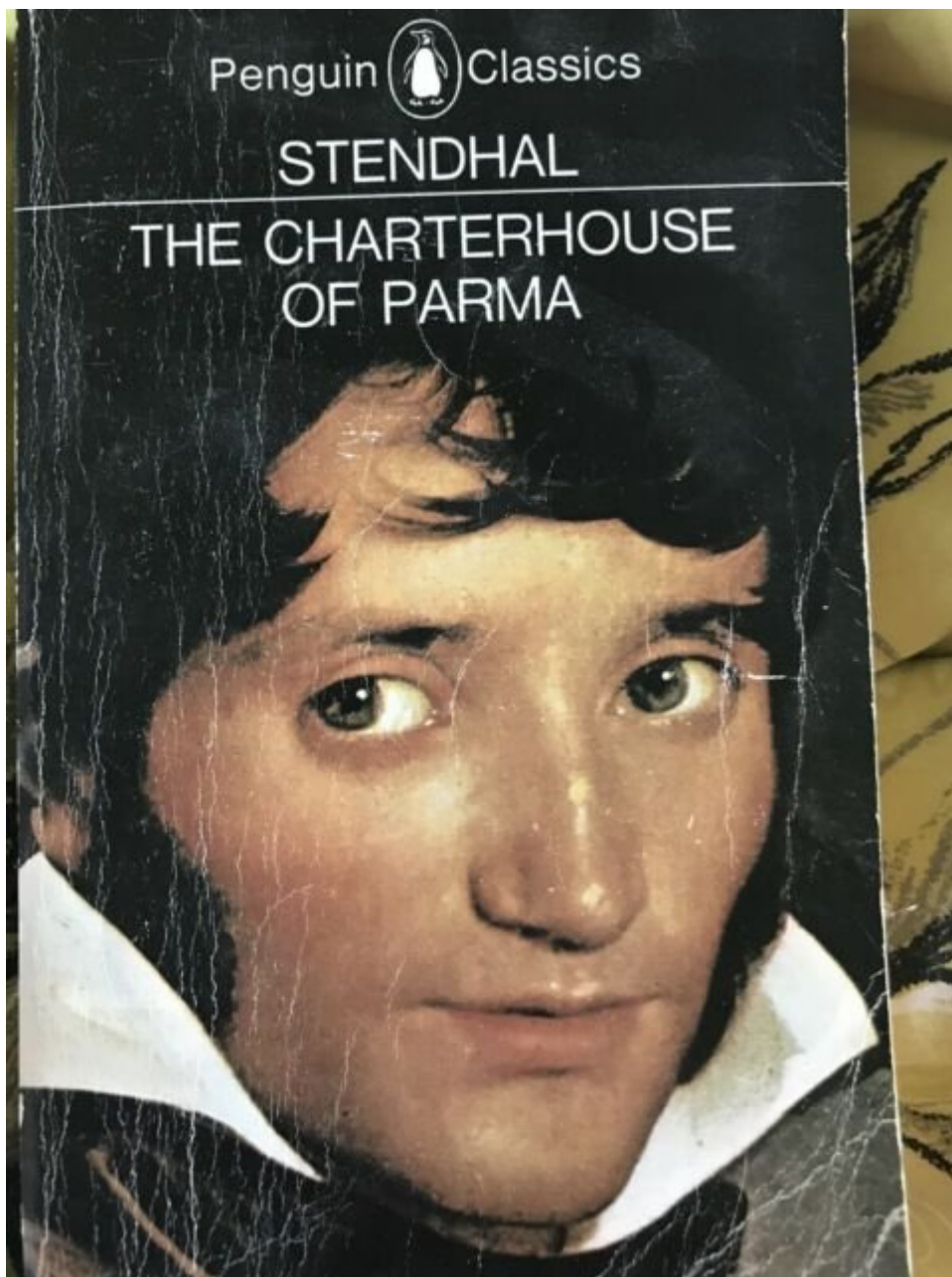
Which book took you the longest time to actually finish reading?
