(known for its finest chalukyan Architecture) ■

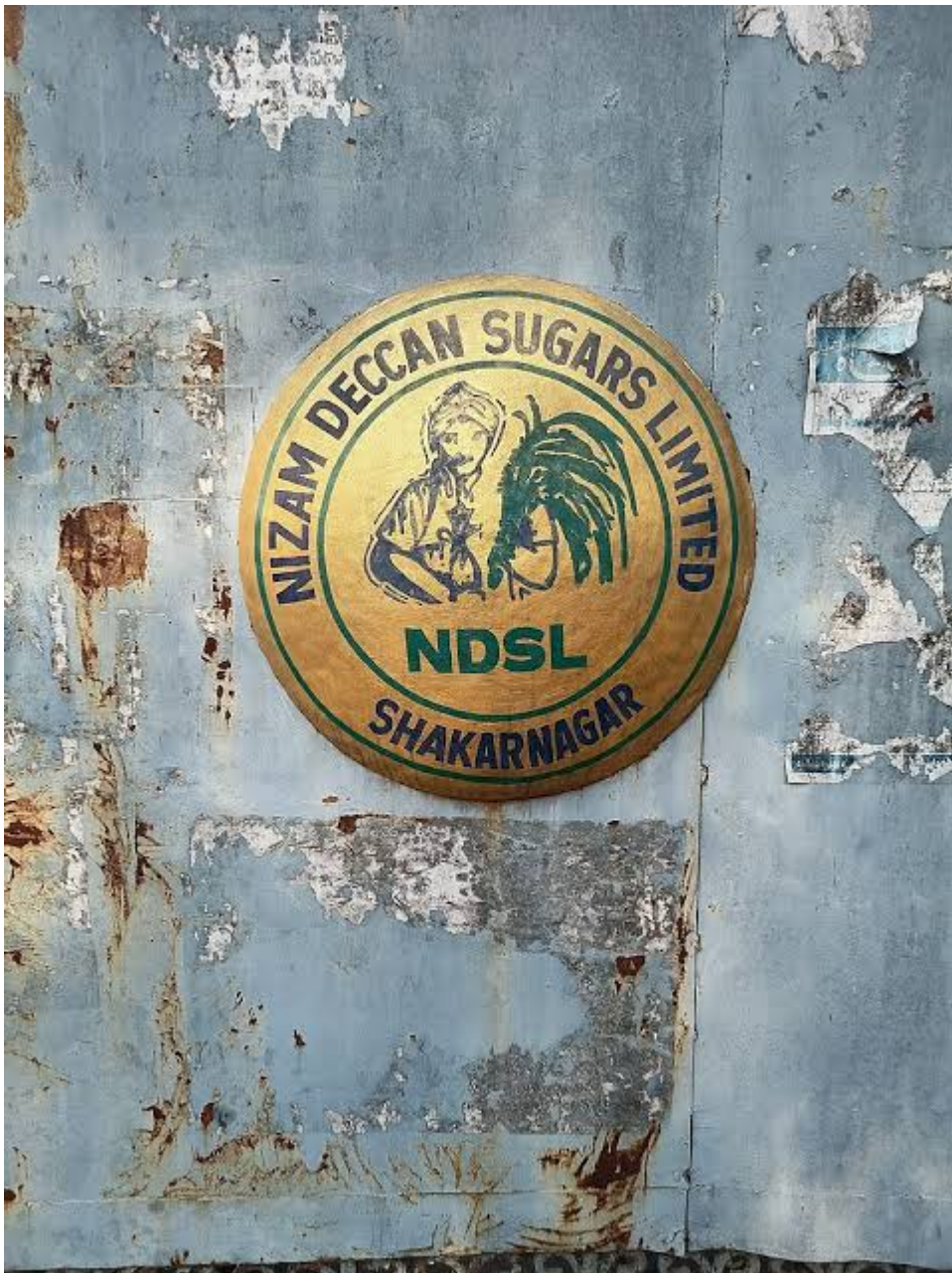

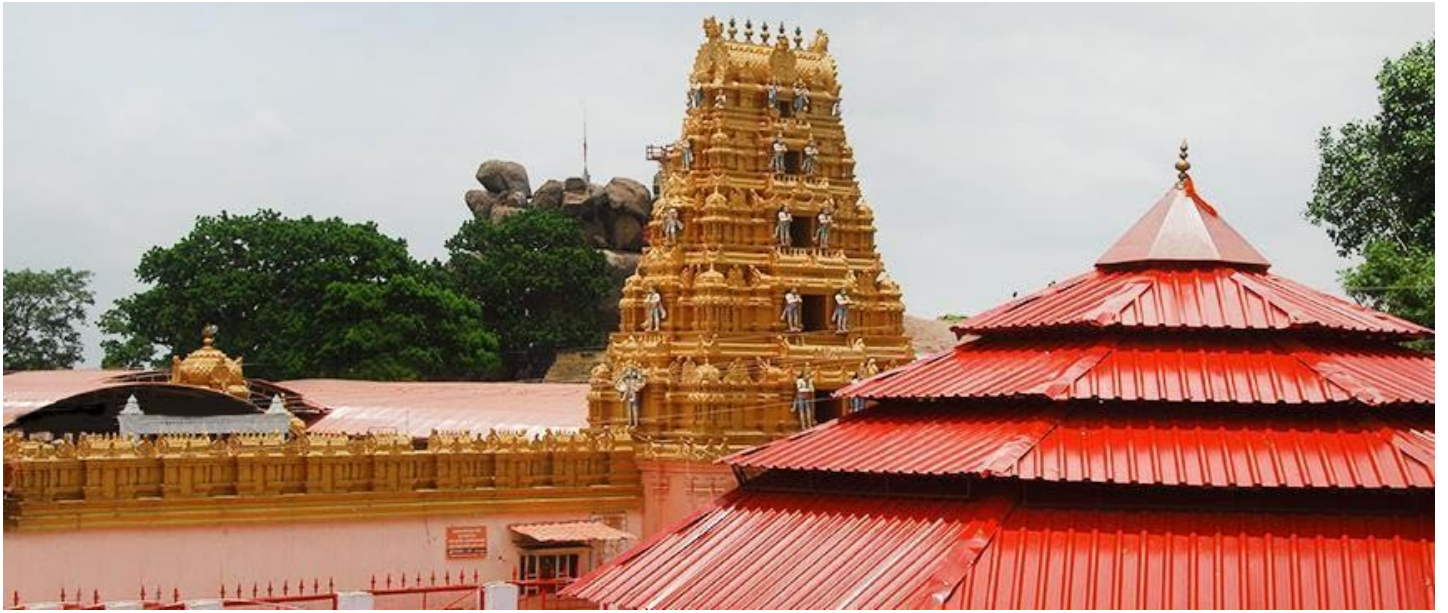

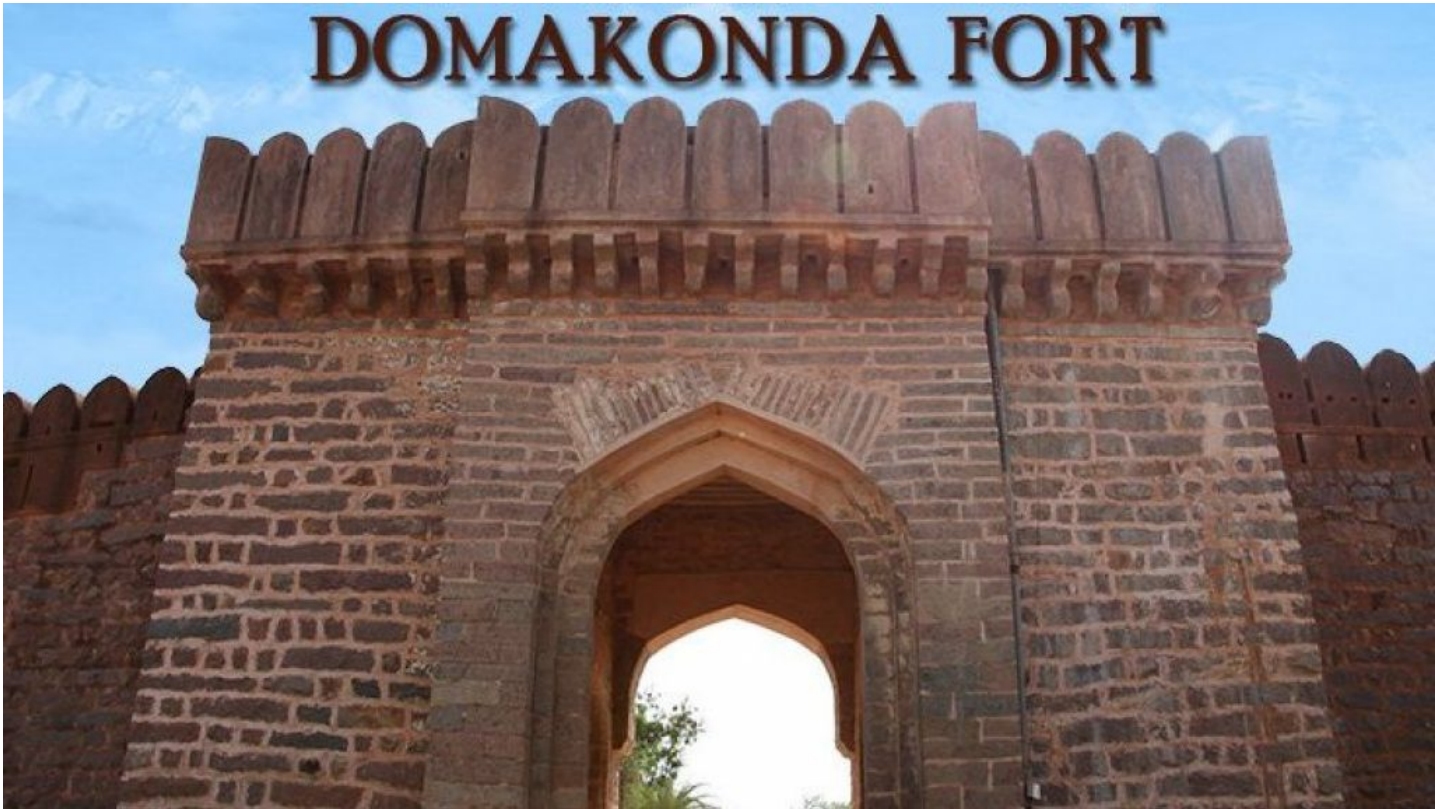
KOTI LINGALA TEMPLE - Karimnagar (10 kms From my Home Town ■) ■♥■
