

## **Ketu and Lord Ganesha connection - Thread**

Ketu is called as a "Moksha Karaka", an indicator of liberation, has the potential to give enlightenment, Ganesha is closely associated with Ketu and is the planetary Overlord of Ketu. Lord Ganesha when prayed to also gives the Moksha.



Even the traditional forms of Ketu & Ganesha are related. The body of Ganesha was created by Goddess Parvati out of clay, then had life infused into it. Later Ganesha had his head decapitated it was replaced with an elephant head. Similarly Ketu is the lower half of snake headless

The deity of ketu graha is lord Ganesha, the elephant headed god, who is the wisdom incarnate. So when ketu native start praying to ganesha, the confusion changes to wisdom. The big elephant head of ganesha represents a huge head full of Wisdom. ketu also represents wisdom.




So for Mula native they gets the triple dose of wisdom, first from maa kali, then ganesha and finally from ketu. Above this mula nakhstra comes under the house of Sagittarius whose ruler is jupiter. Again the giver of true wisdom among the planets.

Also, the symbol of Sagittarius is a bow .which when used with thoughts as sharp arrow from the mind, would truly find their destination. So in reality ,a mula natives has four times the wisdom endowed upon them.

A favorable ketu is said to bring immense knowledge, spirituality as well as luxury. But if someone is facing negative effects of an unfavorable ketu placement in their birth chart then praying to lord Ganesha helps as ketu's overlord is lord Ganesha.

As per Hinduism Lord Ganesh is considered as "Vigana Harta" (one who removes obstacles) & "Buddhi Pradaayaka" (one who grants intelligence). He symbolises good luck and wisdom. This is why he is worshipped first before starting any good work.

Ketu is a graha of obstruction, lord Ganesha is deity of ketu, one should worship him to overcome obstacles created by ketu. "Maha Ganpati Mool Mantra" is very powerful mantra which is chanted to invoke ganesha, the remover of obstacles.
