Since #IndiaAgainstPropaganda maybe you all will find what this propaganda researcher has been writing useful! Here's a tweet thread of my articles analyzing propaganda during several key events over the last two decades (for new readers: I'm a media studies professor [@usfca](#))

Pulwama, the most recent major #hinduphobic terrorist attack on Indians, February 2019 (Hinduphobic because the killer used tropes like cow-piss drinkers, idolaters etc.). Here's how [@nytimes](#) played propagandist: <https://t.co/gI9ANRtYNp>
