**18feet Ranganatha seen in a Bhoga Sayana Posture at Devadhanam located at minjur a small village almost 40 km away from city chennai.**

**dated over a 1000 years rule of the Chalukya kings, situated on a large sand mound.**



History.

The king of Chalukya who happened to visit srirangam wanted to create a similar one within his empire and thus this temple came in to existence. Since then it's been known as vada srirangam.

Why Devadhanam?

Its believed to be gifted by the devas so the name devadhanam came in to picture.

Lord in Bhoga Sayanam

It's believed that Lord Ranganatha is believed that tired of measuring the paddy during the harvest season, to have relaxed his head on the same grain measure.

Moolavar Vighram (idol)

We have perumal rangathanar to be of 18ft long and 5ft high sleeping on Aadhiseshan with his right hand placed beneath his head and left hand stretched forward.

Also moolvar vighraha is made of Salagrama stone, the jewels of the Perumal are of Salagrama stone, the only one of its kind in rangathanar temples. Hence, there is no Thirumanjanam for the Moolavar.

At the feet of perumal we have Sri devi and Bhoo devi. Also, Anjaneya is also seen with folded palms along with Maha Rishi Thumburu inside the sanctum.

Visiting to the temple is said to provide immediate job opportunities, help in marriages and progeny.
