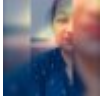

So observing vrata on this Ekadashi removes the misdeeds committed knowingly or unknowingly.

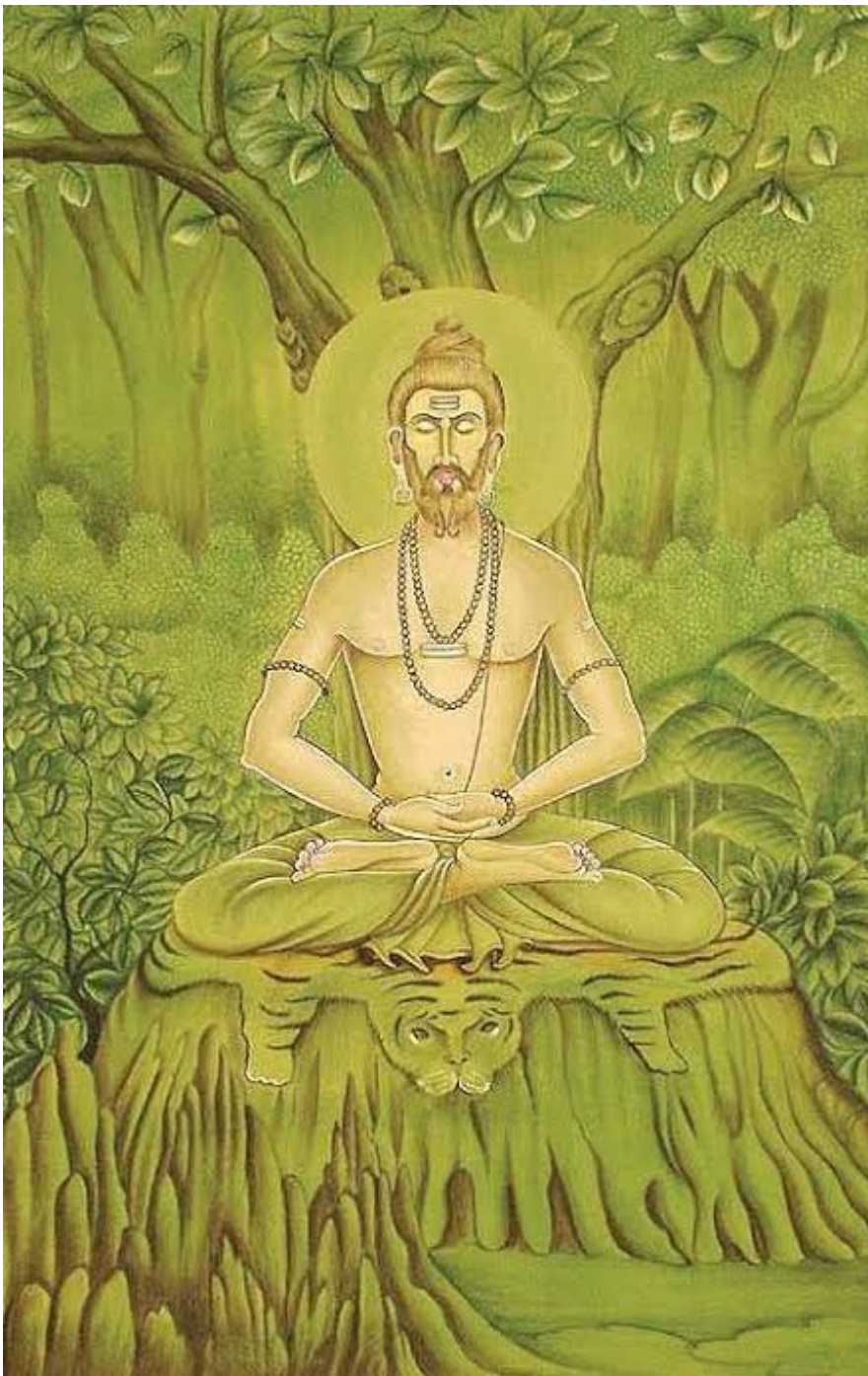
This Ekadasi happens between Holi and Chaitra Navratri.
