




Bhrama Deva was born as Shiva Sharma a priest's son. Shiva Sharma started doing pooja after his father's death. He did Shiva Pooja at very young age

But while doing Abhishekham he could not touch Shivalingam because of it's height. Paramashiva bend down before the child.



The place got it's name Virinchipuram because Brahma Deva, is also called Virinchi. By worshipping here, obstacles relating to marriage are removed. Temple is also important for Surya Sthala as sun's rays falls on the Shivalingam during (March April
