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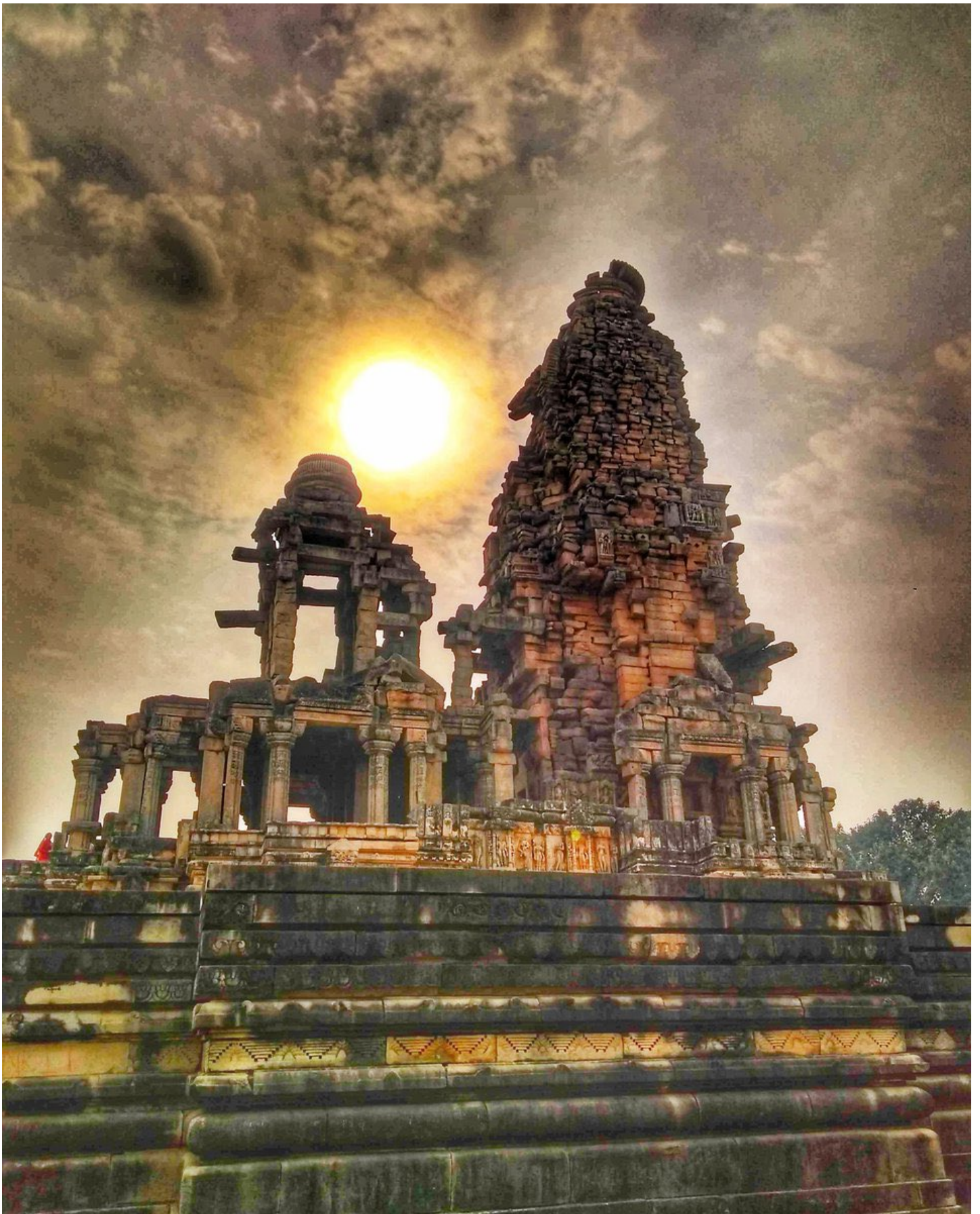
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**The Kakanmath temple was commissioned y Kachchhapaghata ruler Kirttiraja (1015-1035 CE). This can be inferred from a Kachchhapaghata inscription found at the Sas-Bahu Temple in Gwalior**

**Originally, the site had a temple complex, with a central temple surrounded by four subsidiary**

shrines. Only the ruins of the central temple stand now..

The temple stands on an ornate base (pitha). The building includes a sanctum, a vestibule, and two halls (gudha-mandapa and mukha-mandapa). The sanctum has a circumambulatory path with three transepts.

The gudha-mandapa has lateral transepts, and four clusters of pillars; each cluster contains four pillars.
