GHATI SUBRAMANYA, DODDABALLAPURA (KAR) #bharatmandir

One of the most important place for snake worship.

The murtis of Kartikeya and Narasimha are self-manifested.

There is an anthill which is opposite the shrine. Bhaktas pour milk on it as part of rituals.



Here Subramanya performed penance in the form of snake. He sought protection from Narsimha for Nagas from Sri Vishnu's vehicle Garuda, known for his dislike towards serpents.



It was in this region where Subramanya vanquished Ghatikasura, the demon. Hence called Ghati Subramanya. Childless couples visit here to seek blessings for getting a child.

The installation of snake murtis near the shrine is believed to be an auspicious act.



The murti of Karthikeya with a seven headed cobra faces eastwards while Narasimha faces westwards. To ensure that both are visible to bhaktas at the same time, a huge mirror is placed in the rear in the sanctum sanctorum.
