It is time to use more broader words "Rational & Irrational" instead of "RW & LW". Let's understand how.. #RSS RSS which is a Right Wing Org, But at the same time it is "Anti FDI", "Anti Capitalist" & a wing of RSS, "the Labour Organization" has raised its voice many times in favour of "Pro Labour Rights" which are basic features of LW. So will you say that RSS is a LW Org? #Congress Congress which is traditionally a Left to the centre party, in 1991 it introduced the most revolutionary economic reform, the LPG reforms (Liberalisation, Privatization & Globalisation), which are related to free market economy. So, has Congress become a RW party?? #BJP BJP is traditionally a Centre Right party. But it follows all "Socialist Policies of Welfare State" like Manrega. Did BJP ever try to stop these policies..? No, actually BJP promotes these. So should we say that BJP is a LW party??

1. #Bihar

Till 2013, #JDU which claims to be a "Left Socialist Party" was in coalition with #BJP which is a "Center Right Party".
