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One of the most common tasks performed in NLP is the identification of parts of speech (POS).

Therefore, it is useful to know the definition of the basic classes of POS:

1■ Noun

2■ Pronoun

3■ Verb

4■ Adjective

5■ Adverb

6■ Adposition

7■ Conjunction

8■ Interjection

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1■ Noun (NOUN): is the name of a person, place, thing, or idea.

2■ Pronoun (PRON): is a word used in place of a noun.

3■ Verb (VERB): expresses action or being.

4■ Adjective (ADJ): modifies or describes a noun or pronoun.

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5■ Adverb (ADV): modifies or describes a verb, an adjective, or another adverb.

6■ Adposition (ADP): is a word placed before (prepositions) or after (postpositions) a noun or pronoun to form a phrase modifying another word in the sentence.

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7■ Conjunction (CCONJ or SCONJ): joins words, phrases, or clauses.

8■ Interjection (INTJ): is a word used to express emotion.
