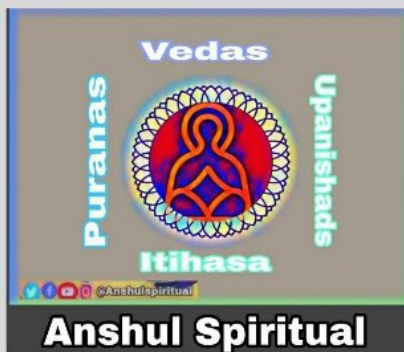

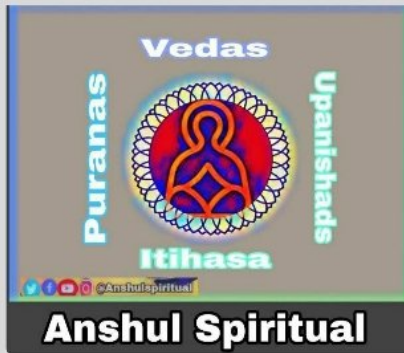
WHAT ALL THINGS YUDHISTHIR LOST DURING DHYUT SABHA!!!!



WHAT ALL THINGS YUDHISTHIR LOST DURING DHYUT SABHA

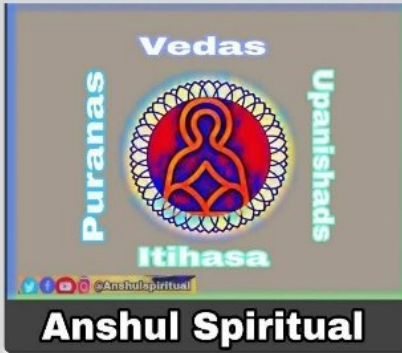

We continue this series from the previous chapters. We had already described as to why Shakuni coaxed Duryodhan to invite Pandavas for this game.

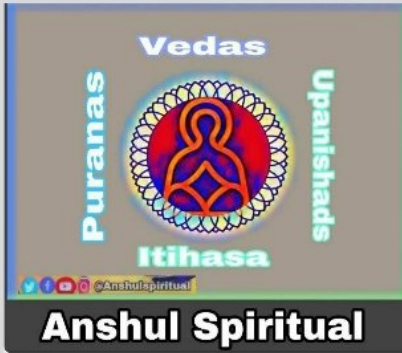

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5) Then he lost one thousand bejewelled elephants,

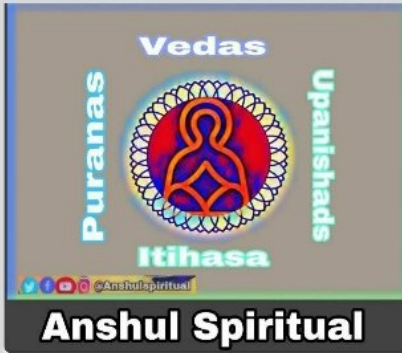
6) Then he lost one thousand golden chariots with able bodied charioteers,

8) Then he lost ten thousand golden horse carts,

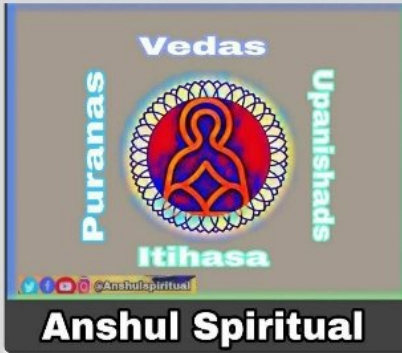
9) Then he lost four hundred trunks full of riches,

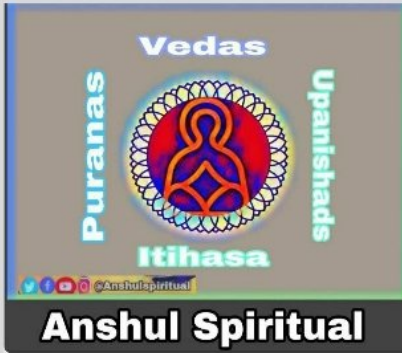


Vidur said that gambling was never a fair game as it brings only suffering and causes enmity which can emerge as greatest friction.

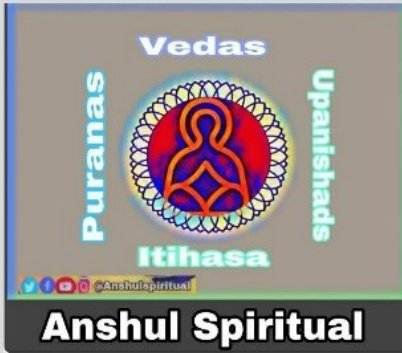
Duryodhan could not accept and tolerate the truth spoken by Vidur.
