The Sphatika Mala is thought to have spiritual properties, as it brings tranquilly and relaxes the mind. This has the power to lower body temperature. 9/n



As a result, people wear it around their necks to keep their body temperatures in check and their minds cool. Sphatika reduces fever and removes excess heat from the body. 10/n

Sphatika Mala's Importance

•Sphatika Malas usually has 108 beads and one central bead called Guru Mani, which is transparent and round/diamond/double diamond cut.

•Sphatika is associated with Venus, according to astrology. 14/n



•Sphatika Mala improves concentration, cools the body, and relaxes the mind.

•Sphatika Mala helps to cool the body.

•Sphatika mala can also be used as a meditation tool.

•Sphatika malas can be used to make Japas for any mantra, but especially Maha Lakshmi and Shukra 15/n

A Sphatika Mala can be worn by anyone.

Sphatika (Rock Crystal) is also known as 'Shivratna,' and wearing a Sphatika mala provides financial, mental, and social advantages. If the moon is incorrectly situated in one's Jataka (birth-chart), a Mala of Sphatika should be worn. 16/n



Pure Sphatika is translucent, and as a result, it improves mental clarity and memory. Sphatika can grant the user the grace of Shukra if they are enthralled by unneeded financial worries. 17/n

If one's labor is not properly credited or rewarded, he or she might establish themselves in society and obtain their rightful share of fame and respect by wearing a Sphatika Mala. 18/n

Alternatively, wearing a Sphatika Mala might be especially beneficial if people overlook the favors that one has done for them or if one feels unduly confronted with unfavorable conditions. 19/n

On Fridays, after chanting 'Om dhraam dhreem dhroom sah shukraaya namaha' and conducting 108 Japa (ritualistic recitations) of the mantra, adorning a Sphatika Mala and doing 108 Japa (ritualistic recitations) of the mantra is good. 20/n

Sumeru, or the crown bead, is the bead tied to the tassel in this mala, and the mala is frequently used to keep track when repeating the mantra. When counting the beads for prayers, one begins at the first bead adjacent to Sumeru and counts all the way to the end. 21/n

When one reaches the 108th bead, one comes to a halt and counts backward. The Guru bead is the Sumeru bead, hence it should not be counted. 22/n

If you wear any gemstone, such as a birthstone, you can wear Sphatika Mala with it because it has no adverse effects and can be worn with any gemstone. 23/n

Sphatika-based product:

Sphatika is also utilized to create idols of many deities, particularly Surya and Shivalinga's images. Srichakra Mahameru, fashioned of Sphatika, is also extremely effective in bestowing blessings on the worshipper. 24/n
