Initially

your mind assumed 3 numbers are missing,

verifying is a painful task,

Information needs to be verified multiple times and that takes time.

and we don't have time

What to do?

Practice: Practice things so much that you can react by intuition

Why? So you can respond intuitively and stay stress-free.

Want an example?

Lets drive..

Initially, When you are learning driving you have to keep in mind

What is my speed

what is gear,

is a car coming from behind

is a truck coming ahead

100 things

With practice, driving becomes easier.

You can change a song while driving,

Phone bhi attend kar lete ho. mat karo

How to practice in trading:

Say you trade with indicators,

say RSI,

if you practice it 1000 times, you will know intuitively when it's buying/sell/overbought, oversold, divergence.

You need enough practice

Now you can count feathers of birds while it's flying

and.

Practice, Practice, Practice.
