The most bizarre story surfacing now is that in 2014, a night before model code of conduct applied for general election, UPA govt 'gifted' 123 prime properties in Delhi to Waqf Board.

The entire matter was executed in a hasty manner within a week that went through chain of approvals by several departments & ministries.

Sub: De-notification of 123 Waqf Properties from Acquisition

Whereas vide Notification No. S.O.661 (E) dated 5.3.2014, 123 Waqf Properties (61 Land & Development Office and 62 Delhi Development Authority) were de-notified and allowed the title to revert to the Delhi Waqf Board or Mutawallis.

Whereas the said notification NO.S.O.661 (E) dated 5/3/2014 was challenged through a Writ Petition (C) No. 2901/2014 titled 'Indraprastha Vishwa Hindu Parishad & others Vs. Union of India & others' before Hon'ble Delhi High Court.

Whereas the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi by order dated 20/8/2014 disposed of the said Writ Petition with the observations that Union of India shall take appropriate decision after giving an opportunity of hearing to all stakeholders in particular Delhi Waqf Board.

Consequently, the Government of India has constituted Two Members Committee vide notification no. L-IIA/25(101)/49 dated 10/02/2021 comprising of Justice (Retd.) S.P Garg and Sh. Radha Charan (Retd. SDM) for providing hearing to all the stakeholders/affected parties of the said 123 de-notified properties as per Annexure A.

Whereas the details of aforesaid 123 properties are also available at the official website of Delhi Development Authority at www.dda.org.in as well as on the Notice Board at the office of the Two Members Committee on any working day from 10 AM to 5 PM. Whereas the Committee has also to demarcate the Waqf Properties and Nazul Land wherever they co-exist.

Through this Public Notice, all the stakeholders/affected parties are invited by the Committee to file representations/statements /written submissions along with the relevant documents regarding ownership/possession of land with contact number, mobile number and email-id, etc. for communication, within 30 days from the publication of the Public Notice.

On receipt of this submissions of stakeholders/affected parties, the objectors/applicants shall be called for the personal hearing at the office of Two Members Committee.

का.आ.661(अ). — केंद्रीय सरकार भूमि अर्जन, पुनर्वास और पुनर्व्यवस्थापन में उचित प्रतिकर और पारदर्शिता अधिकार अधिनियम, 2013 (2013 का 30) की धारा 93 द्वारा निहित शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए निम्नलिखित शर्तों के अधीन रहते हुए भूमि और विकास कार्यालय तथा दिल्ली विकास प्राधिकरण के अधीन नीचे वर्णित वक्फ संपत्तियों के अर्जन प्रत्याहरण करती है, अर्थात् :—
