





A Logical Syllogism:


- >Only Losers are unable to find a quality relationship

Wages and their consequences have been a disaster for the Human Race.




Modernity descends into a curious Equilibrium of Dysfunctional Neglect.

Let's explore the logic.


Western Civilization is a winner-take-all competition... Sexually, Economically.

To complain, or explain the problems of the world is


Cringe Behavior, demonstrating Low-Status.



This is one of the Fundamental Secrets for why everything is getting worse, all around us.




Anyone trying to change a Winner-take-all competition is probably a loser.

Millions of Americans were destroyed


Same as usual.

But I started wondering — why were doctors bribed so easily by the Sackler family?




The answer is Medical Debts.

"The Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) reported that the median medical school debt among the Class of 2021 was \$200,000, not including their undergraduate debt."



Today, doctors function in a sort of Factory model — register the patient, rush them in, rush them out.

Often, basic nutrition and exercise goes unmentioned, in favor of prescriptions.

"It's not unusual for primary care doctors' appointments to be scheduled at 15-minute intervals. Some physicians who work for hospitals say they've been asked to see patients every 11 minutes."



"Shorter visits also increase the likelihood the patient will leave with a prescription for medication, rather than for behavioral change — like trying to lose a few pounds, or going to the gym."




"Doctors are thinking, 'I have to meet my bottom line, pay my overhead, pay my staff and keep my doors open. So it's a hamster wheel, and they're seeing more and more patients ... And what ends up happening is the 15-minute visit."



"The patient is thinking: 'I'm taking the afternoon off work for this appointment. I've waited three months for it. I've got a list of things to discuss.'

"The doctor is thinking, 'I've got 15 minutes.' There is almost a built-in tension."




TLDR: Debt traps doctors to play by the rules of a dysfunctional system.

Otherwise, all their own lies come tumbling down."




This is the trick... groom the Strivers, the Social Climbers, anyone who demonstrates any form of Ambition or Aspiration.
