Shiva said that He was only pleased with the calf. Swamy further said that the place was the first among Mukthi sthalas to his devotees and that he would grant the creation boon to Kamadhenu at Tirukaruhavur and advised it to perform penance there, also..■



This place would be praised as Kamadenupuram and Pattipuri after name of the calf and that he would stay in the place as Patteeswarar.

The foot print scar of Kamadhenu is still visible on the head of Patteeswarar.
