Paramekkavu Bhagavathy temple is one of the largest Bhagwathy temple in Kerala. Temple is just opposite to Vadakkunnathan temple and is one among the two temple which participate in famous Thrissur Pooram.



Sthala puranam says that an elder member of Kuruppal Tharavad, an ardent devotee of Thirumandham kunnu Devi, used to visit there regularly, but due to old age he expressed his inability to visit there anymore to Devi. Leaving the temple with heavy heart,

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he took rest under Ilanji tree in Vadakkunnathan ground. To resume journey he tried to lift his umbrella from ground, but it was firmly fixed there. Later a Deva Prashnam was held and it was told that Devi's presence is in the Umbrella. Everyone started praying Bhagwathy there



later Chaitanyam was transferred to the current location.
