

Mindstamp turns any video into an interactive experience by adding

■ Notes (text, audio, video)

- Pop-up Questions
- CTAs

to any video in seconds

Video is blowing up but is still a one-way interaction: adding context, soliciting feedback, or prompting action still requires separate actions outside of viewing

Mindstamp bridges that gap by doing these things right where the content lives: inside the video itself ■

Items you add to the video stay there and pop up for future viewers at the time you made them: it's like you're right there watching with them

You can add a text note mentioning something coming up, and then solicit their explicit feedback right afterwards with a question ■



Mindstamp can be used to capture + qualify new leads, onboard new customers, educate and support existing customers, share general knowledge, and so much more ■


