1) he had no stone


2) his action was putting his body between them and Shireen Abu Akleh's casket

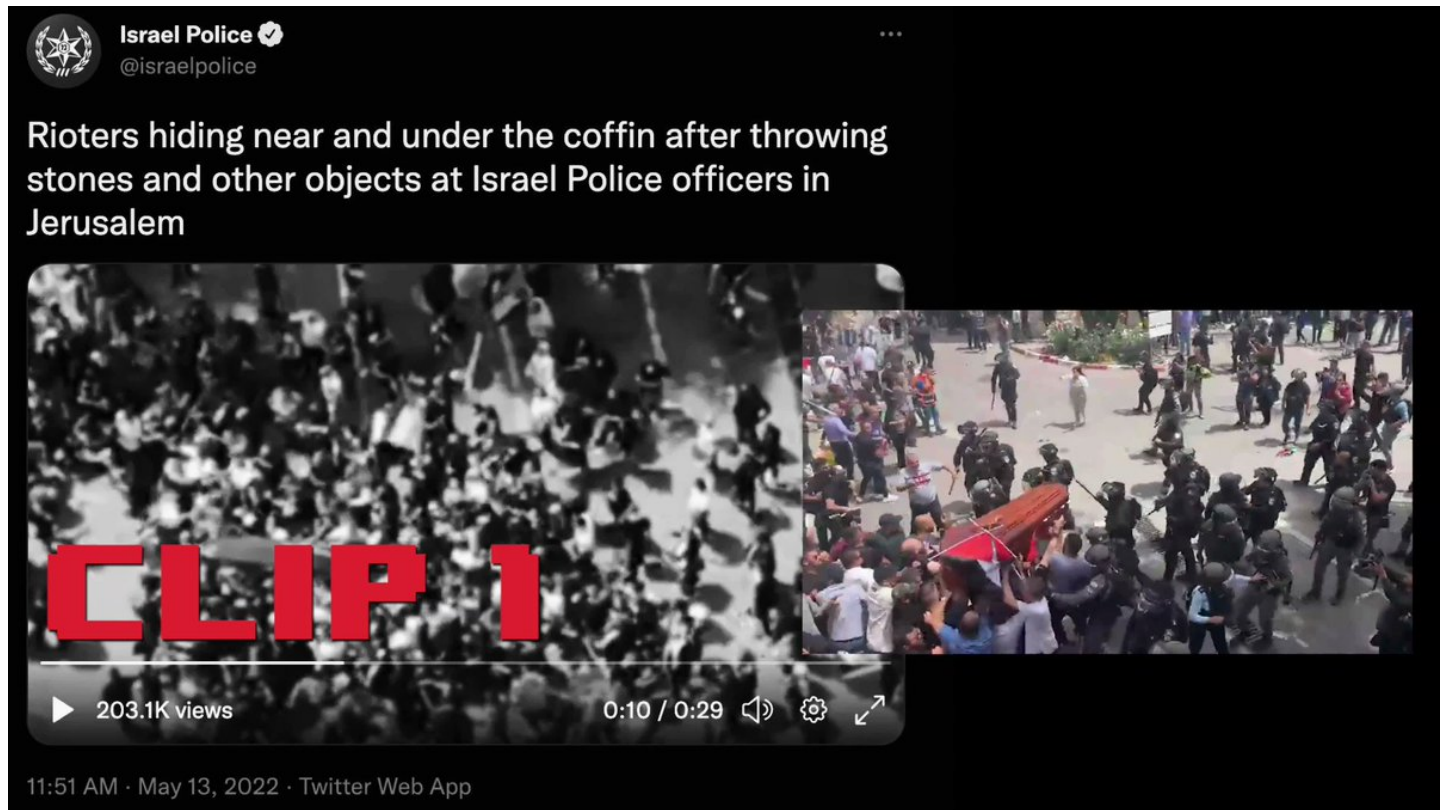
