5. 1st up the BBC who had 4 attendees. Anthony William Hall who was Director-General at the time, presenters Sally Bundock & Mishal Husain also Economics Editor Faisal Islam (formerly Sky). Both Bundock & Husain are in the WEF. The BBC has also received more than \$50m from BMGF

Controversial columnist George Monbiot wasn't although he is in WEF.


The Guardian are funded by BMGF for \$15m. They don't try & hide it either as BMGF frequently appear sponsoring articles


11. The world's "premier" fact checking company Thomson Reuters just had 15 attending. WEF also.


12. Global magazines such as the Economist and Time were also in attendance as was Bloomberg. Time & Bloomberg are also WEF partners.






