

After the wedding, Kiki recalled having met <u>@Gurprit</u>, founding director of <u>@EthicalReading</u>, back in March when she arrived. She got back in touch with him and soon became a #volunteer, with assignments focused on Reading Ethical #RecruitmentCharter.
