Has anyone had an experience with Lincoln Towing? The following is my experience with them after being informed of two separate incidents that occurred this afternoon in the Binnys parking lot at 4901 W. Irving Pk Road.

As some of you are already aware, Lincoln Towing was hired to remove any and all vehicles that illegally use parking spaces between Irving and Dakin behind Binnys.

Culvers leases 25 spaces for customers, and if one chooses to use a spot, one MUST go directly into Culvers and NOT visit another business prior to entering theirs. (Hope that helps someone.)

Unfortunately for two vehicle owners this afternoon, each made the mistake of visiting another business prior to purchasing an item at Culvers which ended up in a tow and costing each person \$218.50. (One of the passengers in the towed vehicle being a 92 year old woman with breathing difficulties.)

Upon learning of the situation, I immediately attempted to intervene by inquiring to see if a middle ground could somehow be settled upon.

Once on the scene, it was clear a resident in a nearby home had other issues related to the tow truck drivers that were unresolved which prompted some taunting and harassing language by the driver toward the resident.

After identifying myself and informing the driver of who I was, I made it clear that comments such as the ones I heard were unnecessary and unwarranted, and that no one would speak to our residents in such a manner.

To our friends on the 5000 block of W. Dakin and surrounding area, the days of having to suffer from the bullying and harassment from these individuals are over. Those type of acts and language is unacceptable and will not be tolerated!

In the coming days I look forward to having discussions with representatives from both Lincoln Towing and the owner of the parking lot to see where they stand regarding this issue.

I think you already know where I stand. More importantly, to the residents of our community, where do you stand?
