Unbroken for 82 years



Largest production car When it comes to size, one car leaves its rivals in the dust. First built in 1927, the Bugatti "Royale" type 41 is more than 6.7 m (22 ft) in length. Its bonnet is over 2.13 m (7 ft) long.

Unbroken for 70 years



Highest box office Taking inflation into account, epic weepie *Gone With The Wind* (USA, 1939) is the top-grossing movie ever, having taken \$5,362,000,000 (£2,916,000,000) at the box office.

Unbroken for 62 years



Largest plane by wing-span The H4 Hercules flying boat, a.k.a. the Spruce Goose, has a wingspan of 97.51 m (319 ft 11 in) and a length of 66.65 m (218 ft 8 in). It flew just once, on 2 November 1947.

Unbroken for 55 years



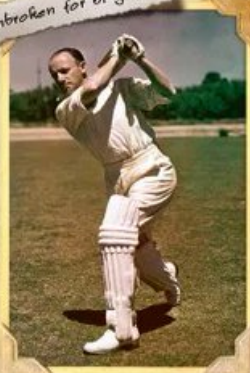
Best-selling single by a group Recorded on 12 April 1954, "Rock Around the Clock" by Bill Haley and his Comets (USA) has sold an unaudited 25 million copies. That's what we call a record!

TALLEST MAN EVER

He's perhaps the single most famous record holder in the history of GWR. Robert Pershing Wadlow (USA) was the **tallest man** ever recorded, standing 272 cm (8 ft 11.1 in) tall, with a weight of 199 kg (439 lb) at his peak. Wadlow's hands (unsurprisingly, the **largest hands** ever measured) were 32.3 cm (12.75 in) from the wrist to the tip of his middle finger and he wore a size-25 ring (pictured). This remarkable man was also the owner of the world's **largest feet**: he wore US size-37AA shoes (UK size 36, or approximately a European size 75), the equivalent to 47 cm (18.5 in) in length. Indirectly, it was his outsize feet that brought about Wadlow's untimely demise. He died after he developed a blister on his left foot while he was making a round of public appearances. The blister became infected, Wadlow's health deteriorated dramatically, and he died in his sleep on 15 July 1940, aged just 22.

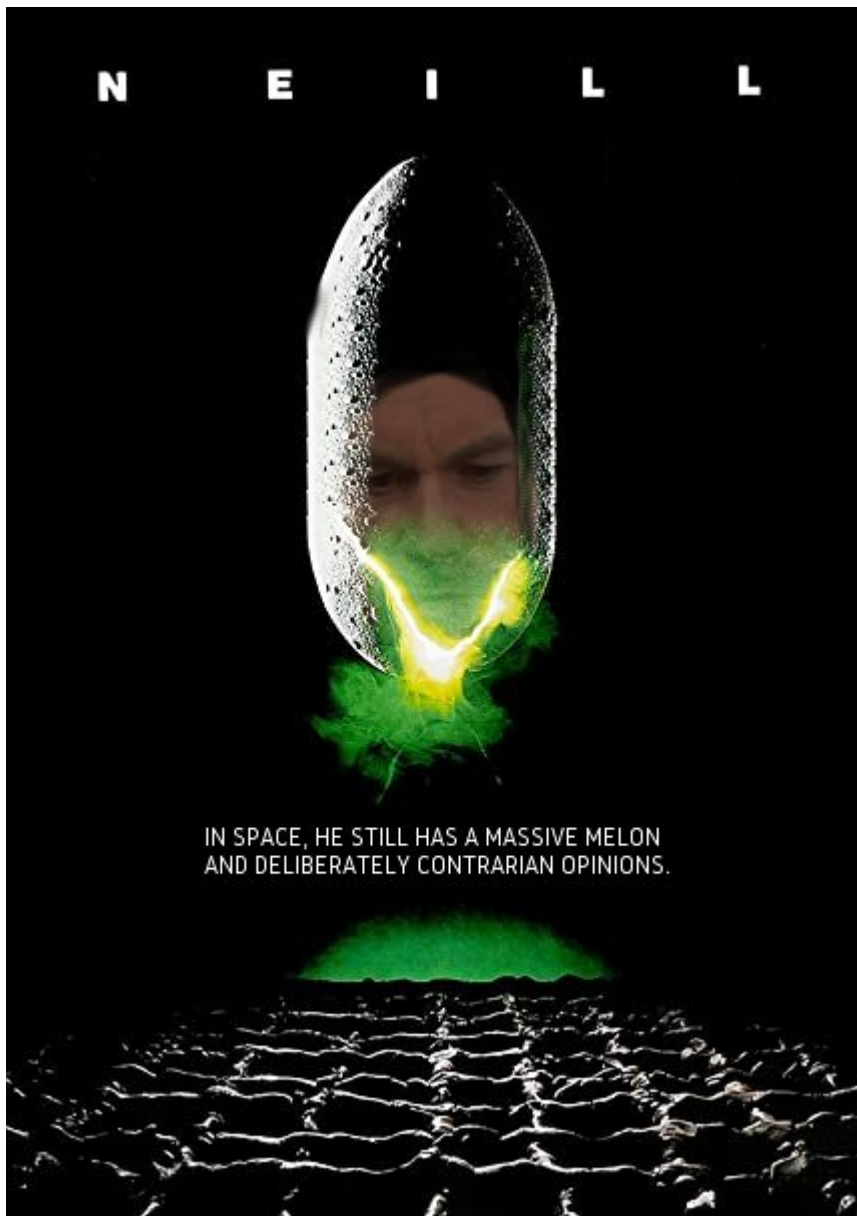
