






ONE OF THE MOST FASCINATING UNITS OF WW2 WAS THE 23RD HEADQUARTERS SPECIAL TROOPS. A UNIT SPECIALIZED IN MILDEC. FORMED JANUARY 1941, THIS ORGANIZATION HAD ONE MISSION: TO DECEIVE THE ENEMY ON THE BATTLEFIELD.

CAMP FOREST, TENNESSEE; WOULD SERVE AS THE ARMY POST TO ARRANGE THE MOST UNIQUE FORMATIONS IN ARMY HISTORY.

CLASSIFIED "TOP SECRET" UNTIL 1996, THE 23RD WAS THE SIZE OF JUST 1,100 PERSONNEL. THE COMMANDER OF THE ORGANIZATION, COL HARRY L. REEDER (THE ONLY COMMANDER) SAW THE UNIT JUST AS A HOLLYWOOD PRODUCTION TEAM AND HAD ARTISTS WITHIN THE ORGANIZATION.

The unit was organized with one battalion, 3 company separates and one headquarters company. Each unit had its specific role that was the personification of MILDEC doctrine...or shall I say PSYOP Doctrine? 4/

The Command Group and Headquarters Company managed talent and provided command and control.
