

Here's the official notification.

EVACUATE: Cannon due to Police Activity. Occupants should:

- * Remain calm and move in a safe manner to the exits.
- * If nearby, take annunciators on the way out.
- * Close doors behind you but do not lock.
- * Proceed immediately to your designated assembly area and check in with your OEC.
