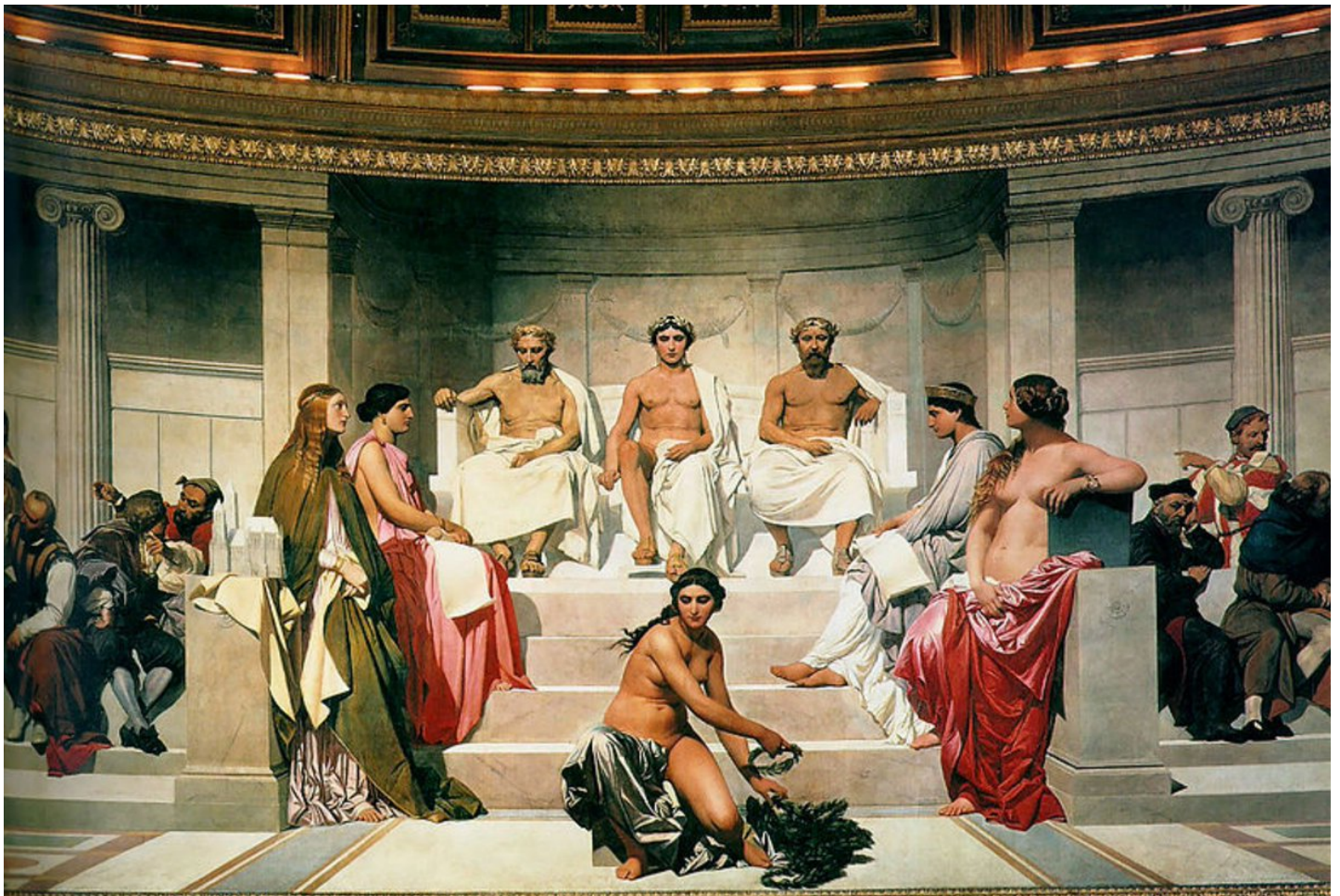

Distance yourself from advertising.

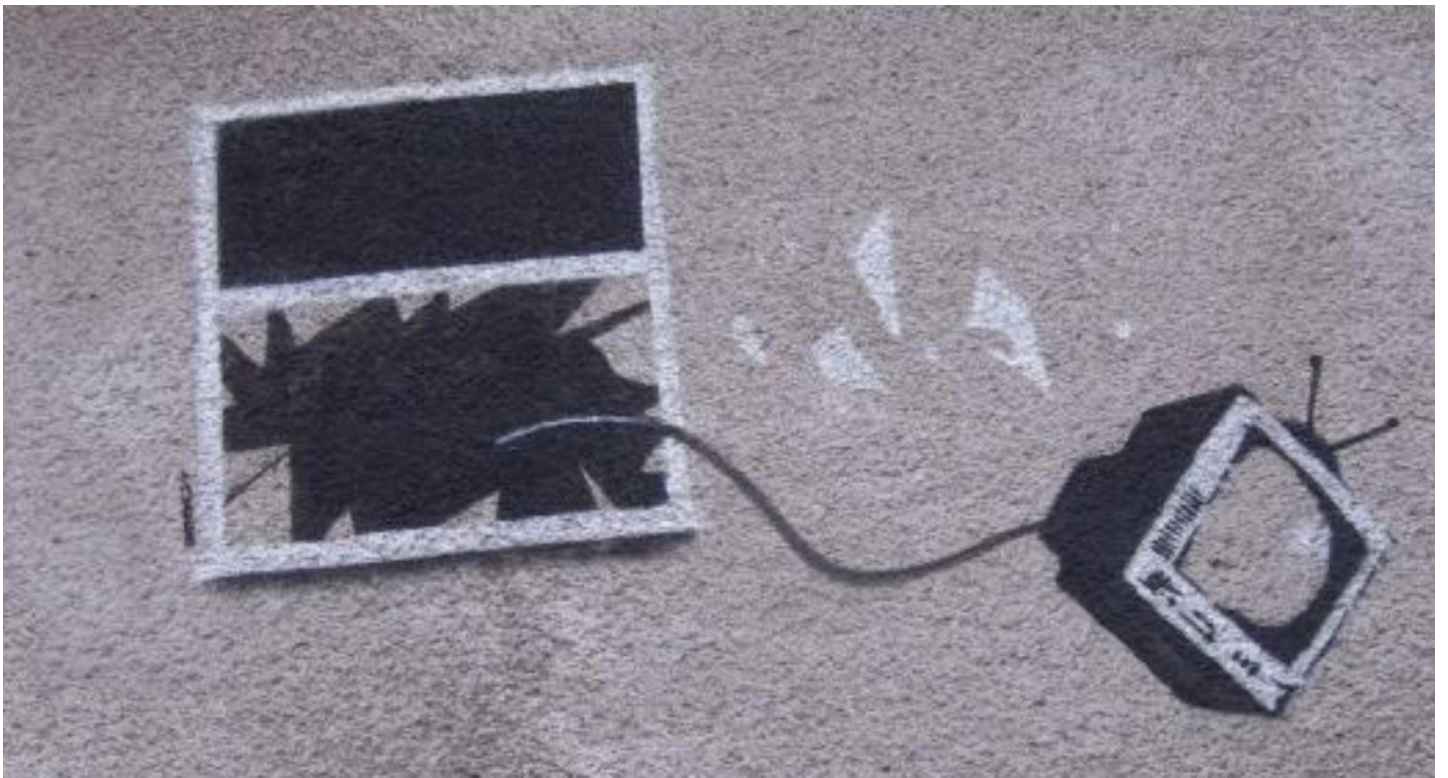

There is a reason why TV is free.



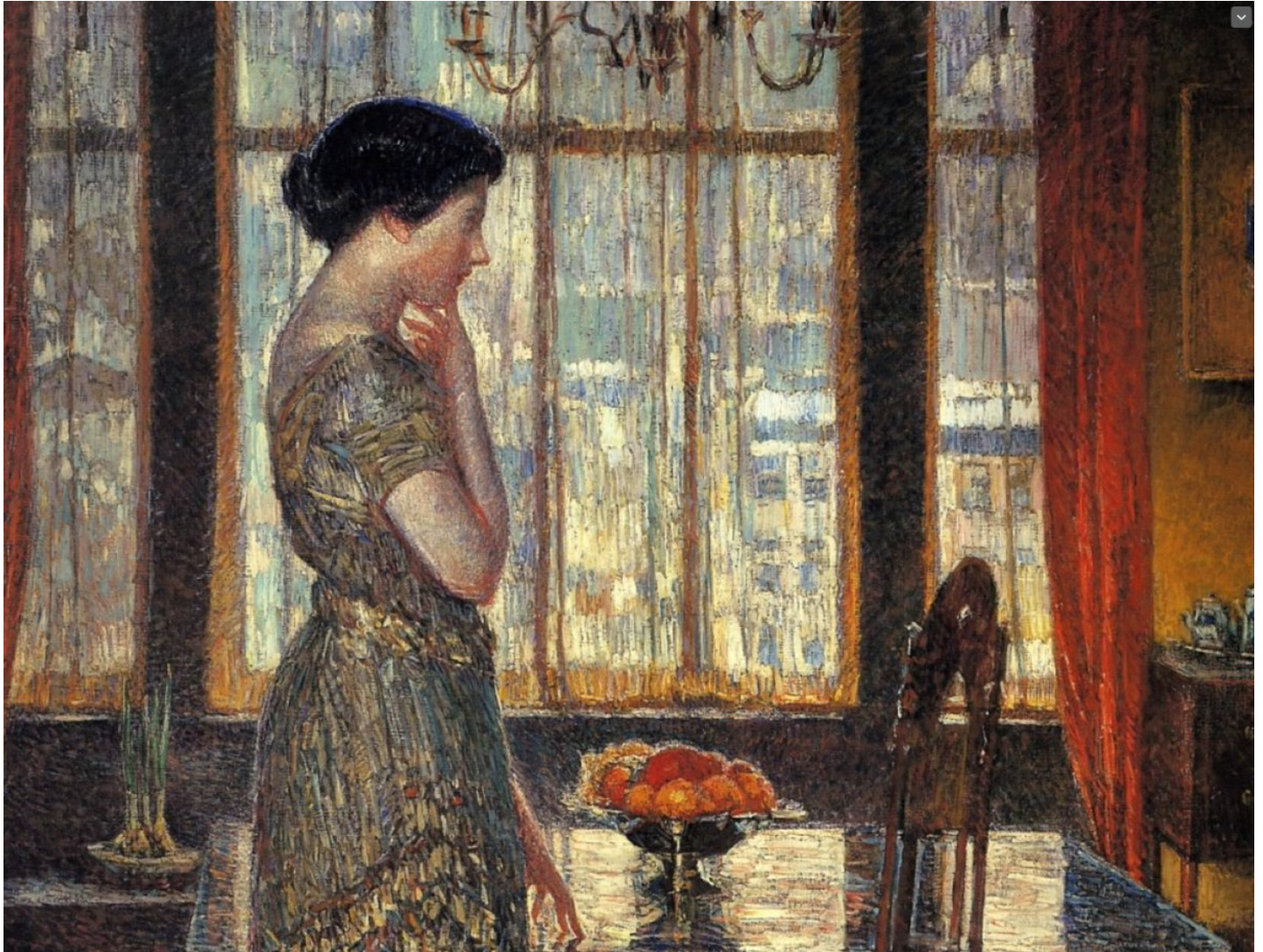


## 7 Mindset Shift from Consumerism
