Zapata County had 725 new voters

2016 Votes for Prez =3142

2020 Votes for Prez = 3867

Did these new voters all vote for Trump? Could be since Trump got over 1000 new votes

2016 Trump Votes =1029

2020 Trump Votes = 2032

In 2020 Biden got 12% LESS VOTES than Hillary in 2016■

When I looked at Kentucky I found a county with more registered voters than age-eligible people. Same in Zapata.

In 2018 they estimated 6,683 people above the age of 18

In 2020 they had 8,257 registered voters

Zapata seems to have 24% MORE registered voters than people over 18?

Counties showing more registered voters than people may be due to officials not maintaining their voter rolls. People who move or die are often not removed.

But it also presents opportunity for those with nefarious intent. For example, Russia targeted systems in all 50 states.

Zapata wasn't the only odd results. Trumps 2016 Rio Grande Valley performance, a mostly Hispanic–Latino population, was dismal & represented a GOP 80-yr-low.

But again in 2020 he nearly doubled his votes

Some say its due to heavy campaigning, but there may be other explanations

In 2018, reports of vote flipping in the Beto-Cruz race were so prevalent the Sec of State addressed the issue. Texas didn't dispute it, they just told people to be careful when they voted.

RE: Voting on Hart eSlate Machines

We have heard from a number of people voting on Hart eSlate machines that when they voted straight ticket, it appeared to them that the machine had changed one or more of their selections to a candidate from a different party. This can be caused by the voter taking keyboard actions before a page has fully appeared on the eSlate, thereby de-selecting the pre-filled selection of that party's candidate.

Specifically, the Hart eSlate system uses a keyboard with an "Enter" button and a selection wheel button. The "Enter" button on a Hart eSlate selects a voter's choice. The selection wheel button on a Hart eSlate allows the voter to move up and down the ballot. It is important when voting on a Hart eSlate machine for the voter to use one button or the other and not both simultaneously, and for the voter to not hit the "Enter" button or use the selection wheel button until a page is fully rendered. A voter should note the response to the voter's action on the keyboard prior to taking another keyboard action. It is also important for the voter to verify their selections are correct before casting their ballot. Step-by-step [instructions for the use of a Hart e-Slate machine](#) are available on [VoteTexas.gov](#).

As a reminder, voters should always carefully check their review screen before casting their ballots. If a voter has any problems, they should notify a poll worker immediately so the issues can be addressed and reported.

By the time the Judge halted the plot, out of the 98,000 voters who got threatening letters, ONLY 80 people (.0008%) were found to be ineligible to vote.
