A Question Which Begs To Be Answered:

Q Why Did Fulton County Georgia report on television they had a **93.67% vote adjudication happening?**

NOTE: In the 2016 general election, voters submitted nearly 33.5 million mail ballots, but more than 400,000 (1.2% of the total) weren't counted, according to data from that year's Election Administration and Voting Survey. In 2018, 2.1% of the 30.2 million domestic civilian mail ballots, or nearly 628,000 votes, didn't make the cut.
