What is required to learn mantra shastra?

You will find a good number of Eastern Europeans, Ukrainians and Russians realising very fast that their PAIN has no solution AND normal mantras take pronunciation and time to work!



They come and learn from Shabar traditions and sit and follow the path- peace comes slowly.

I know a few Italians/ Eastern Europeans and others who came to the banks of the Ganga... learnt .. never commercialised what they learned and got what many Indians could never imagine..
