The new boxes are going to look more like this. But maybe not exactly like this, because y'know --parent feedback--, which they'll be soliciting (not ignoring) now! They'll be considering <u>@MarcusRashford's</u> review that's going on, and getting a nutritionist involved also.

That's all well and good, but that's their job isn't it? They are meant to deliver a good service... Are they sorry? Hmm? Words are cheap. I want to see more than remembering how to do your job and some pretty words. It needs to hurt.

So how much? How much do we think?...

Oh I dunno, ten thousand pounds is a number that sticks in my mind. You feeling it? Let's make it hurt by £10k shall we?
