

The Hutch-Kinahan feud has been relatively quiet in recent months, as wars between gangs in Dublin and <u>Drogheda</u> connected to Owen Maguire and Cornelius Price have gained worldwide headlines.

The murder of Keane Mulready-Woods in Drogheda has seen a new wave of extreme violence.

The 17-year-old was kidnapped and dismembered before his body parts were dumped around the capital to send a message to rivals.


