




A reminder of the Newsnight expose on The Tavistock.



Homophobia was a factor in the resignation of over forty staff over a three year period.



Girls openly telling staff they suffered homophobia in the family and at school.

I had a case. There was a lot of trauma in the family. The young person had come out initially as a lesbian and had faced a lot of homophobic bullying, both very subtly within the family and quite openly in school.

Eventually they ended up identifying as trans.

Suddenly, the young person changed their mind and they started identifying as trans.


Parents openly stated they would prefer a trans kid rather than a gay one subject to parental pressure? Director of GIDs pushing prescribing despite clinical concerns.

The young person had very clearly told me and my colleague that, 'my mum wants the hormone more than I do' and when we took it to senior management - Polly Carmichael - she suggested that we refer, even though this was not clinically indicated.


Staff raising concerns over many years. (Over 15 years in some cases as it turns out)
