1/ Trump should have been a release valve for the anger and frustration of ordinary Americans. That's what populism has historically been in America, a release valve.

6/ It seems likely that a Biden administration will allow the social media companies and big corps to institute a backdoor, Chinese-style social credit system, one that will ban Americans from social media and shut them out of services such as banking. (It's already started.)

7/This will force the right to become more politically active and aggressive. No more grilling for anyone. Now you've got to be more political than the left.

This is bad for them, because our side has mountains of untapped talent, in people who are normally apolitical.

8/ This newly awakened populist right will dominate at the polls in 2022 and 2024, ushering in someone who will make Trump seem tame.

And because the left allowed corps to aggressively police right wing speech, the newly triumphant populist right will clean house.

9/What cleaning house means, is outright destroying leftist institutions. Defunding colleges, busting social media monopolies, and demanding public adherence to patriotic American values.

An aggressive, populist, civic nationalist right will make them howl like never before.

10/Personally, I prefer a Trump victory.

But, recognize that the Derp Start, the left and the media are playing with fire.

If they succeed in getting rid of the Orange Man, and then go too hard to prevent another populist from rising, they'll unleash a cleansing hurricane.

11/ The anger is there, the pressure is high. I don't think we'll get a Civil War 2.0, but we can get a political movement that they'll regret forever.

And if they criminalize the right and try to throw Trump in prison, they'll get something even worse than politics.
